## TOP 10 LIST OF 'MUST-HAVES'

1

### EMBROIDERY MACHINE

Obviously! Your machine should fit your budget. It should also meet your present needs and be able to support your expanding skills.

### THREAD/BOBBINS

There are many brands of threads and bobbins. Make sure you are using Embroidery Thread and Bobbin Thread specifically designed for Machine Embroidery.

### HOOPS

Your machine should come with hoops. Know all the hoop sizes your machine will take. This will expand your possibilities as you learn.

### STABILIZERS/FABRICS

Fabrics, Tearaway and Cutaway stabilizers are the foundation of your projects. Depending on the project there are different weights of each.

5

### NEEDLES

Learn what needle your machine takes and have a few extra on hand. You will break a few in the beginning.

6

### TOOLS

Gather the basic tools needed to complete small projects: Scissors, tweezers, marking pens, chalk, pins, tape, etc. \*Put them all together in a secure place.

7

### DESIGNS

Learn what designs and fonts come with your machine. See how you can apply those to your first projects.

8

### LAPTOP

If your machine requires software to run it you may need a laptop. If you wish to purchase or create your own designs, you may want to invest in one.

9

### SOFTWARE

Additional software may be needed to purchase and download designs, and manipulate files to create projects.

10

### SPACE

Find a space to work on projects where they will be left alone by curious hands and paws.
